Bus News/Spring Game Info

It is a new year, a new team, new coaches, but the same old bus chairman. Even though it is very early in the calendar year, new enthusiasm is evident in our 2010 football team as by lines from the alumni, boosters, and several other sources indicate that preseason ticket sales are up several hundred percent. If you want season tickets, it is now time to renew or call the ticket office at 888-FSU-NOLE and reserve your tickets. Once again, the club will have a bus to all home games, so start planning on reserving bus seats if you are going to be a season rider. We have 7 home games and the schedule is posted on all the FSU/Nole nets and web sites. We are in the process of negotiating a contract with a bus company and reserving a bus for our 7 home games. At this time, the cost of season bus passes is uncertain, but if gas prices remain the same, we anticipate the cost to be close to the charges that we have made in the past two years. Bus seat prices are determined by FSU's charge for parking the bus, bus cost and gas prices. The club will begin taking payment for season passes from July 1st to August 15th. Any remaining seats for individual games will be sold on a first come basis beginning August 16th. **GO NOLES!!!!**

Some people have indicated an interest in taking the bus to the Spring Game on April 10th. Since our bus requires 30 days advance reservation, there is a very short window in which to attempt to pay insurance liabilities and charter and prepay for the bus. If you are definitely interested in riding the bus and if we have a minimum of 40 prepaid riders, then we will try to complete all the necessary contracts and negotiations. Definite commitments and notification need to be sent to jcookkbee2@aol.com by **Monday, March 8th** at the latest. Approximate cost would be \$40 per person.
